Dr. Bowhay has extensive experience providing career coaching and mentorship to underserved student populations. He currently serves in a variety of volunteer roles for the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators (NASPA), the National Association for Campus Activities (NACA), and the Sigma Phi Epsilon national fraternity. His goal as a BCC is to continue to advance his current work with his local community by providing advanced career coaching to support students in developing and achieving career and employment goals that lead to meaningful lives.
